| 10 | WHEREAS, | TOUA requests permission to build and operate the Ak Chin Arsenic |
| 11 | | Regionalization Project and appurtenances (collectively, the "Project") on the |
| 12 | | Nation's land between the Ak Chin and Santa Rosa communities within the Gu |
| 13 | | Achi District; and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, | the Project is funded under the Safe Drinking Water Act ("SDWA") Tribal Set- |
| 15 | | Aside Program through the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA"), |
| 16 | | Region 9, to assist tribes with making improvements to their public drinking |
| 17 | | water system infrastructure with direct grants awarded to tribes or interagency |

| 19 | WHEREAS, | EPA's Tribal Set-Aside Program is being used to fund the Greater Santa Rosa |
| 20 | | Regionalization Water System's ("GSRRWS") Arsenic Regionalization Project to |

| 22 | | specifically within the Santa Rosa area and the adjacent community of Ak Chin , |

TOUA has provided legal descriptions and a Map of Definite Location for the 2 Project which encompasses approximately 51.91 acres of land and such legal 3 descriptions and Map of Definite Location are attached hereto and incorporated 4 herein by this reference; and 5 WHEREAS. the Project is funded through the Indian Health Service and will be constructed 6 by TOUA, which will own and operate the Project; and 7 WHEREAS. the Project will be of substantial benefit to the Ak Chin Community, and its 8 members, and the Archie Hendricks Sr. Skilled Nursing Facility; and 9 WHEREAS. the Gu Achi District Council approved the proposed Project on February 11, 10 2011, by District Council Resolution No. 211-399; and 11 WHEREAS. the Nation's Realty Office, in conjunction with the Nation's Office of Attorney 12 General, has developed preliminary procedures entitled Process for 13 Recordation of TOUA's Utility Corridors on the Nation's Lands-IHS Projects 14 ("Utility Alignment Procedures") that would grant TOUA a "utility alignment." 15 which would vest TOUA with the right to construct the Project; and 16 WHEREAS. the Nation's Realty Office, the Nation's Attorney General, Indian Health Service, 17 and TOUA have all reviewed the Utility Alignment Procedures and have agreed to 18 use the Utility Alignment Procedures, dated April 1, 2015, for a period of one 19 year to see if these procedures address some of the documentation and 20 recordation issues that have been encountered by various TOUA projects; and 21 WHEREAS, the Project area has been reviewed and approved by the Nation's Cultural Affairs 22 Office, on June 9, 2014, and by the Nation's Wildlife and Vegetation Management 23 Office, on May 6, 2015; and 24 WHEREAS. the Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee has reviewed the Project 25 utility alignment, the Project's supporting documents and its scope of work and 26 the Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council grants to 27 28 TOUA a right to utility alignment for the requested Project to be constructed 29 between the Ak-Chin Community and the Santa Rosa Community, located within 30 the Gu Achi District, provided that TOUA will submit to the Nation's Realty Office 31 an acceptable Application for Utility Alignment with all documentation required

 by the Application and a survey grade Map of Definite Location, prepared in accordance with 25 CFR §169.10 and 25 CFR §169.6(d) as these sections may be amended from time to time, certified by a registered professional engineer or an Arizona Registered Land Surveyor.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby grants approval of any encroachment permits for this Project, including future individual services installed on the system, which may be granted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to federal regulations to allow the utility alignment or service lines to individual customers to cross roads constructed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11^{TH} day of FEBRUARY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3.021.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2(d) of Article VI, of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
