## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving Intergovernmental Personnel Act Agreement and Memorandums of Agreement with IHS Employees)

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-075** 

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "promote,
2		protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education, and general
3		welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" and to "consult,
4	:	negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono
5		O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments" (Constitution of the
6		Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Sections 1(c)(2) and 1(f)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") has historically contracted for certain
8		federal programs, functions, services or activities ("PFSAs") of the Indian Health
9		Service ("IHS") pursuant to the authority conferred on the Nation by the Indian
10		Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act of 1975 (P.L. 93-638; 25 U.S.C. §
11		450 <i>et seq.</i> ); and
12	WHEREAS,	in Resolution No. 15-365, the Legislative Council authorized the assumption of
13	·	remaining federal programs, functions, services, and activities carried out by
14		the IHS for or in support of the Nation; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Nation is engaged in negotiating and implementing a self-governance
16		compact with the Indian Health Service for the operation of the Sells Service
17		Unit and related Area and Headquarters functions; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Nation intends to enter into Intergovernmental Personnel Act agreements in
19		accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 3371-3376 or Memorandums of Agreement in
20		accordance with P.L. 93-638, Section 104(B) for IHS employees; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the resolution and
22		model agreements and recommends approval.
23	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
24		model Intergovernmental Personnel Act Agreement and Memorandum of
25		Agreement for IHS employees substantially in accordance with the model forms
26		attached hereto and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute the
27		appropriate agreements with IHS employees and to take any other action
28		required to carry out the intent of this resolution, provided that such
