

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Holding March 9, 2016 General Session in Phoenix, Arizona for Oral Arguments in
***Tohono O'odham Nation v. Ducey*)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 16-083

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing
3 committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono
4 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** Article I, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative
6 Council, as amended, provides that "[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be
7 held at the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells,
8 Tohono O'odham Nation, with the following exceptions. . . [a] majority of all the
9 legislative representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other
10 than the chambers located at Sells."; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Economic Development Delegation has requested the Legislative Council
12 hold its March 9, 2016 general session in Phoenix, Arizona for oral arguments in
13 *Tohono O'odham Nation v. Ducey, et al.* with roll call beginning at 11:00 a.m.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the March
15 9, 2016 general session shall be held in Phoenix, Arizona for oral arguments in
16 *Tohono O'odham Nation v. Ducey, et al.* with roll call beginning at 11:00 a.m.

17 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH day of
18 MARCH, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,071.5 FOR; -0-
19 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 949.9[07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
20 by Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
21 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
22 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
23 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
