

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving License Agreement Between Pima Community College and the
Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 16-088

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council**
2 **with the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on**
3 **behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments**
4 **and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political**
5 **subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the**
6 **authority of the Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section**
7 **1(f)); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has consistently supported the pursuit of higher**
9 **education for its members; and**

10 **WHEREAS, in 2010 a License Agreement, which was subsequently approved by Legislative**
11 **Council Resolution No. 13-465, with Pima Community College was executed to**
12 **provide the Education Department office space at the College's Desert Vista**
13 **Campus; and**

14 **WHEREAS, in an effort to update the terms of the License Agreement the 2010 License**
15 **Agreement was terminated on June 30, 2015; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department seeks to enter into a new**
17 **License Agreement with Pima Community College; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees of the**
19 **Legislative Council have reviewed the Facility License Agreement with Pima**
20 **Community College, which is incorporated by this reference, and recommends**
21 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**
23 **the Facility License Agreement between Pima Community College and the**
24 **Tohono O'odham Nation, in substantially the form attached hereto, and**
25 **authorizes the Nation's Chairman to execute the License Agreement.**


26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH**

29 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
30 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
32 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
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


