

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2016 Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch Budget Amendment #2)**

RESOLUTION NO. 16-096

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 2016 Judicial Branch**
2 **Budget by Resolution No. 15-169 and further amended the budget by resolution**
3 **15-370 for a total budget of \$6,218,200.54; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch has evaluated the positions within the branch and has**
5 **determined that there is no longer a need for the Adult Probation Supervisor**
6 **position; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch recommends taking the salary and benefits of the Adult**
8 **Probation Supervisor position in the Personnel line items and moving those**
9 **funds into the Operational line items in the amount of \$69,843.98; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the funds in line item 7430 RM Grounds will be moved into line item 7420 RM**
11 **Building; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the following new line items would also be added to the budget: 6500 Training**
13 **Fees and Registration; 6510 Lodging; 6520 Per diem; and 7340 Public Relations;**
14 **and**

15 **WHEREAS, the language in line item 7305 General Liability Insurance will be amended to**
16 **include "Court Clerk II's insurance renewal for the National Notary Association";**
17 **and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch has prepared the attached Budget Amendment #2 to reflect**
19 **the changes listed above; and**

20 **WHEREAS, this amendment will not increase the total budgeted amount; and**


21 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative Council**
22 **have reviewed this budget and recommend its approval.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
24 **approves the FY 2016 Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch Budget Amendment #2**
25 **as attached.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
27 **Chief Judge and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
28 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level**
29 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
30 **Legislative Council.**

31 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
32 **day of MARCH, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,896.1 FOR;**
33 **125.3 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
34 **by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
35 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
36 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
37 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


