1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council
2		with the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on
3		behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments
4		and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political
5		subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the
6		authority of the Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section
7		1(f)); and
8	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has members who reside in the San Lucy District in
9		Maricopa County; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department provides law enforcement
11		services to the San Lucy District, but on occasion requires mutual aid assistance
12		from other law enforcement agencies to meet the needs at San Lucy District; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation and Maricopa County have negotiated the attached
14		Mutual Aid Agreement, which provides the San Lucy District with Law
15		Enforcement assistance from the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office Deputies will have the authority to assist
17		the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department, within the boundaries of the
18		reservation, by enforcing the laws of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
19	WHEREAS,	in exchange the Tohono O'odham Police Department will provide law
20		enforcement services when requested to assist the Maricopa County Sheriff's
21		Office in enforcing the law relating to all crimes of the State of Arizona as set out
22		by the Arizona Revised Statues within the boundaries of the City of Gila Bend;
23		and
24	WHEREAS,	this agreement will remain in effect until March 1, 2021; and
25	WHEREAS,	the Mutual Aid Agreement requires a limited waiver of the sovereign immunity
26		of the Nation in favor of the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office to allow the terms
27		of the Mutual Aid Agreement to be enforced; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed this
29		Intergovernmental Agreement, including the limited waiver of sovereign
30		immunity, and recommends its approval.
31	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves
32		and authorizes the following:
33		1. Waiver of the Nation's Sovereign Immunity. The Legislative Council
34		grants a limited waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Nation from suit

or action in favor of the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office on the terms set forth in the Mutual Aid Agreement.

2. Approval of the Mutual Aid Agreement. The Legislative Council authorizes and approves the Mutual Aid Agreement with the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office in substantially the form attached and authorizes the Nation's Chairman to execute the Mutual Aid Agreement.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day of MARCH, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-AGAINST; [02] NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
