RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Opposing Arizona Senate Bill 1418)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-112

1 WHEREAS. the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation establishes the Nation's policy 2 "to promote efforts which will preserve and protect the natural and cultural 3 environment of the Tohono O'odham Nation, including its lands, air, water, flora 4 and fauna, its ecological systems, and natural resources, and its historic and 5 cultural artifacts and archeological sites" and vests the Legislative Council with 6 the authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements... on behalf of the 7 Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments" 8 (Constitution, Article XVIII, Section 1 and Article VI, Section I(f)); and 9 WHEREAS. the Arizona State Museum is the state's official permitting agency for 10 archaeological and paleontological projects across Arizona, administers the 11 Arizona Antiquities Act, assists state and federal agencies in enforcing related 12 legislation, and plays an important role in the repatriation of remains affiliated 13 with Arizona Indian tribes: and 14 WHEREAS. Arizona Senate Bill 1418 would undermine the Arizona State Museum's ability to protect archeological resources within the State of Arizona, properly repatriate 15 16 human remains and funerary objects, and otherwise meet the State's legal 17 obligations to the Nation and other Indian tribes, and the Cultural Preservation 18 Committee therefore recommends opposition to this bill. 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it opposes 20 Arizona Senate Bill 1418 and any similar legislation. 21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10^{TH} 22 day of MARCH, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-23 AGAINST; _0_ NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by 24 Article XVIII, Section 1 and Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham 25 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the 26 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to 27 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 28 29 HONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 30 31 32 33 nin, Legislative Chairman 34 35 . 2016 36 37 ATTEST: 38 39 40 Evonne Wilson, Legislative Secretary 41 42 day of Much, 2016
