

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Budget Amendment #1 to the Water Resources Department FY 16
SAWRSA budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 16-150

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the authority "to adopt, approve and amend annual budgets and to authorize the**
3 **expenditure of funds in accordance with these budgets." (Constitution, Article VI,**
4 **Section 1(d)(3); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the Water Resources**
6 **Department FY16 SAWRSA budget through Resolution 15-198 in the amount of**
7 **\$1,801,956.77; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Water Resource Department is requesting a budget amendment #1 to freeze**
9 **the vacant Hydrology Technician position, effective February 5, 2016; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department is also requesting to decrease the Salary and**
11 **Fringe Benefit line items by \$65,307.00 and increase the Professional Service line**
12 **item by \$65,307.00; and**

13 **WHEREAS, there will be no change to the total budget amount; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Tohono**
15 **O'odham Legislative Council have reviewed this budget amendment #1 and**
16 **recommend its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
18 **approves Budget Amendment #1 to the Water Resources Department FY 16**
19 **SAWRSA budget to:**

- 20 **1. Freeze the vacant Hydrology Technician position.**
- 21 **2. Decrease the Salary and Fringe Benefit line items by \$65,307.00.**
- 22 **3. Increase the Professional Service line item by \$65,307.00, in accordance**
23 **with the budget attached hereto.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
25 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget, as**
26 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
27 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
29 **day of APRIL, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
32 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


