

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the FY 2016 Senior Services Division Elder Conference**  
**Budget Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-155**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **witinin the exclusinve control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to**  
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**  
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**  
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**  
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(3); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Senior Services Division Elder Conference Budget in the amount of**  
8 **\$95,550.00 was approved by Resolution No. 15-165; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Senior Services Division has prepared and submitted for review and approval**  
10 **its FY 2016 Budget Amendment No. 1, which Increases line items 7355**  
11 **Professional Services and 7665 Client Support; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Senior Services Division Elder Conference Amendment No. 1 will**  
13 **increase the Senior Services Division FY 2016 Elder Conference Budget by**  
14 **\$15,000.00 from \$95,550.00 to \$110,550.00; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have**  
16 **reviewed the FY 2016 Senior Services Elder Conference Budget Amendment No. 1**  
17 **and recommend its approval.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
19 **FY 2016 Senior Services Elder Conference Budget Amendment No. 1 which**  
20 **includes a \$15,000.00 increase from \$95,550.00 to \$110,550.00 that shall be funded**  
21 **by the Nation's general fund surplus.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legisaltive Council hereby authorizes the**  
23 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
24 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**  
25 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18<sup>TH</sup>**  
27 **day of APRIL, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**  
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
30 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


