

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Baboquivari District Administration FY 2016 Budget Amendment No. 3)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-177

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the Nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Baboquivari District Budget in the amount of \$2,089,369.21 was**
8 **approved by Resolution No. 15-374 which was amended by Resolution No. 15-406**
9 **for Amendment #1 and Resolution No. 16-011 for Amendment #2 which increased**
10 **the overall budget to a new total of \$2,137,881.84; and**

11 **WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved FY2016 Apportionment of Mining**
12 **Royalties by Equal Distribution by Resolution No. 16-017 which allocated**
13 **\$115,253.30 to each District; and**

14 **WHEREAS, Baboquivari District will be incorporating a portion of their FY 2016 Mining**
15 **Royalties in the amount of \$16,464.74, which will increase Line Item 7060 Food in**
16 **the amount of \$464.74, Line Item 7355 Professional Services in the amount of**
17 **\$10,000.00 and establishing new line item 7500 Major Capital in the amount of**
18 **\$6,000.00; and**

19 **WHEREAS, this amendment #3 will affect Baboquivari District Administration's FY 2016**
20 **current budget in the amount of \$707,292.04, to a revised amount of \$723,756.78**
21 **and will affect the overall Baboquivari District FY 2016 budget in the amount of**
22 **\$2,137,881.84 to a revised budget of \$2,154,346.58; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee have reviewed Baboquivari District**
24 **Administration FY 2016 Budget Amendment No. 3 and recommend its approval.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
26 **Baboquivari District Administration FY 2016 Budget Amendment No. 3 as**
27 **attached, incorporating a portion of their FY 2016 Mining Royalties in the amount**
28 **of \$16,464.74.**

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that amendment #3 creates a new line item 7500 Major Capital and
2 will affect Baboquivari District's FY 2016 current budget in the amount of
3 \$707,292.04, to a revised amount of \$723,756.78 and will affect the overall
4 Baboquivari District FY 2016 budget in the amount of \$2,137,881.84 to a revised
5 budget of \$2,154,346.58.

6 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
7 District Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the
8 budget, provided that any modifications or amendments shall be submitted for
9 prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH
11 day of MAY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-
12 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
13 Article VI, Sections 1 (d)(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
14 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
15 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
16 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
