

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2016 Real Property Management Program Revenue Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-199**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department Real Property**  
8 **Management Program is responsible for the repairs, maintenance and grounds**  
9 **keeping for the DaVita Dialysis Center and the San Simon Health Center Staff**  
10 **Housing Units; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and**  
12 **submitted for review and approval the FY 2016 Real Property Management**  
13 **Program Revenue Budget, which will be funded by the Lease Revenue Account;**  
14 **and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Commerce and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY 2016**  
16 **Real Property Management Program Revenue Budget and recommend its**  
17 **approval.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
19 **FY2016 Real Property Management Program Revenue Budget in the amount of**  
20 **\$68,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's Lease Revenue Account.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
22 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
23 **expend the FY 2016 Real Property Management Program Revenue Budget,**  
24 **provided however, that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for**  
25 **further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup>**  
27 **day of MAY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,792.8 FOR;-0-**  
28 **AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and 228.6[08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
29 **by Article VI, Sections 1 (d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**  
30 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
31 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
32 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**






