1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Council with the
2		authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,
3		education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"
4		and to "consult with the Congress of the United States and appropriate federal
5		agencies regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation and
6		all federal appropriation estimates and projects for the benefit of the Tohono
7		O'odham Nation" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(j)); and
8	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Government Comment Guidelines provide in part that Nation's
9		written comments that "take a position supporting or opposing a federal, state,
10	:	or local government action require Legislative Council approval" (1 Tohono
11		O'odham Code Chapter 3, Section 3103(C)); and
12	WHEREAS,	the Census Bureau issued a notice regarding a May 26-27, 2016 meeting of the
13		National Advisory Committee on Racial, Ethnic and Other Populations to discuss
14		the 2020 Census Program overview, tribal enrollment questions, tribal
15		consultations, and working group reports (April 29, 2016 Federal Register Notice);
16		and
17	WHEREAS,	while a portion of the May 27th meeting will be set aside for public comment,
18		individuals with extensive questions or comments are asked to submit them in
19		writing; and
20	WHEREAS,	the data gathered for each decennial census and the American Community
21		Survey, which is an ongoing survey that the Census Bureau uses to accumulate
22		information on an annual basis, is integral and directly tied to federal funding for
23		a wide range of services including transportation infrastructure, health care, and
24		housing, and also affects Nation's members' representation in state and federal
25		governments; and
26	WHEREAS,	in recognition of the importance of the upcoming 2020 census and the American
27		Community Survey, the Housing, Rules, and Appropriations Committees
28		recommend submitting written comments to the Census Bureau's National
29		Advisory Committee on Racial, Ethnic and Other Populations.
