

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting May 26, 2016 Special Session for Self-Governance Proposal Update)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 16-209

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and**
2 **procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing**
3 **committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council**
6 **with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative**
7 **Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has requested a special session on**
9 **May 26, 2016 for a self-governance proposal update beginning at 1:00 p.m.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a**
11 **special session on May 26, 2016 for a self-governance proposal update beginning**
12 **at 1:00 p.m.**

13 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH day of**
14 **MAY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,369.05 FOR; 652.35**
15 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
16 **Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
17 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
18 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
19 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
