1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,
2		negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono
3		O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments on all matters
4		within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council" and to "manage any funds
5		within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation and to
6		appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members"
7		(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f) and 1(d)(2);

9	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated the Department of Health
10		and Human Services, Division of Senior Services, which provides services for the
11		Nation's elders; and
12	WHEREAS,	funding for the Division of Senior Services' operation is made possible, in part
13		by Title III of the Older Americans Act, which provides for funds that are
14		administered through the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. ("ITCA"); and
15	WHEREAS,	Title III funds are necessary for the program to continue to provide nutrition,
16		socialization, transportation, and home delivered meal services to eligible
17		elders and to continue to provide caregiver support services to caregivers of
18		elders and elders raising grandchildren; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Nation's process for grant fund applications provides that "[i]f an Executive
20		Department's grant fund application is approved by its appropriate funding
21		authority, that Department must then seek review and approval by the
22		appropriate Committee(s) of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and the
23		Chairman of the Nation to receive and expend such grant funds." (Process for
24		Grant Fund Applications by the Executive Branch, approved by Resolution No.
25		99-059, amended by Resolution No. 16-149); and
26	WHEREAS,	the ITCA's Area Agency on Aging, Region 8 was awarded a new five-year contract
27		by the Arizona Department of Economic Security, Division of Aging and Adult
28		Services and has extended to the Nation a five-year Funding Agreement for Older
29		Americans Act, Title III Funding and FY 2016 Notification of Grant Award, which
30		is contingent on State funding to the Nation; and
