12	WHEREAS,	Choulic Community approved to amend their FY 2016 Budget increasing the
13		following line items 6120 Worker's Comp, 6215 Employer Dental, 7000 Supplies
14		Office, 7100 Utilities, 7400 RM Equipment, and establishing a blanket purchase
15		order with Arizona Office Technologies in the amount of \$500.00, line item 7620
16		Miscellaneous Assistance, and adding language "but not limited to", line item
17		7640 Emergency Assistance; line item 7645 Wake Assistance, decreasing line
18		item 7355 Professional Services; and
19	WHEREAS,	this amendment No. 3 will not affect Choulic Community's FY 2016 current
20		budget in the amount of \$213,214.75, nor will affect the overall Baboquivari
21		District FY 2016 budget in the amount of \$2,154,346.58; and

23		Budget Amendment No. 3 and recommends its approval.
