## LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Setting June 21, 2016 Special Session for a Presentation of University of Arizona Programs and Support Services for Native Americans)

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 16-238** 

1 WHEREAS. the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and 2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing 3 committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono 4 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and 5 WHEREAS. the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council 6 with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative 7 Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and 8 WHEREAS. the Human Resources Development Committee has requested a special session 9 on June 21, 2016 for a presentation of University of Arizona programs and support 10 services for Native Americans.
