

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2016 United States Department of Justice, Office of Community
Oriented Policing Services, Tribal Resource Grant Program – Equipment/
Training, Award No. 2013HEWX0006 Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-239

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d) (2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the United States (U.S.) Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Community**
8 **Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Tribal Resource Grant Program (TRGP)**
9 **Equipment/Training Award No. 2013HEWX0006 in the amount of \$570,725.00 was**
10 **accepted and approved by Resolution No. 14-063; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety's Law Enforcement Program has prepared and**
12 **submitted for review and approval its FY 2016 U.S. DOJ, COPS, TRGP**
13 **Equipment/Training, Award No. 2013HEWX0006 Budget, which is incorporated by**
14 **this reference and which (1) Approves the grant modification; (2) Creates line item**
15 **7010 Program Supplies and 7500 Capital; and (3) has not applied Indirect Cost to**
16 **this grant; (4) the budget period is from September 1, 2015 through August 31,**
17 **2016; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
19 **2016 U.S. DOJ, COPS, TRGP Equipment and Training, Award No. 2013HEWX0006**
20 **Budget and recommend its approval.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
22 **FY 2016 United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented**
23 **Policing Services, Tribal Resource Grant Program - Equipment/Training, Award**
24 **No. 2013HEWX0006 Budget effective September 1, 2015, in the amount of**
25 **\$34,853.14 that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund.**

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono Legislative Council authorizes the Department of**
27 **Public Safety's Law Enforcement Program to expend funds from the attached**
28 **budget for the period of September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016 on a**
29 **reimbursement basis and to utilize the Nation's resources pending**
30 **reimbursement from the Grantor for the continuation of this grant.**

5 **modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Legislative Council.**

7 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH day**
8 **of JUNE, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,801.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
9 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 219.9 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
10 **VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3)of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
11 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
12 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
13 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
