

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting June 14, 2016 Special Session to Address, Review, and Consider Self-Governance Compact)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 16-247

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and**
2 **procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing**
3 **committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**


5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council**
6 **with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative**
7 **Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has requested a special session on**
9 **June 14, 2016 to address, review, and consider the Nation's proposed self-**
10 **governance compact with the Secretary of Health and Human Services.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a**
12 **special session on June 14, 2016 to address, review, and consider the Nation's**
13 **proposed self-governance compact with the Secretary of Health and Human**
14 **Services.**

15 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH day of**
16 **JUNE, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,412.25 FOR; 389.25**
17 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 219.9[06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
18 **by Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
19 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
20 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
21 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
