14		7355 Professional Service; (5) decreasing 7230 Lease/Rental; (6) creating line
15		item 7420 RM Building; and
16	WHEREAS,	the FY 2016 Hewel Ni'ok CPB CSG Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase the CPB
17		CSG FY 2016 Budget of \$265,116.81 by \$18,203.98 of carry forward funds from FY
18		2015 to a new total amount of \$283,320.79; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Cultural Preservation and the Budget and Finance Committees have
20		reviewed the FY 2016 Hewel Ni'ok CPB CSG Budget Amendment No. 1 and
