	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 09-267, the Legislative Council established a minimum
6		General Fund Surplus Reserve "in order to plan for contingencies, maintain a
7		good credit standing, minimize indebtedness, allow for long-term investment,
8		and to ensure cash availability for operating cash flow"; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Nation's General Fund Surplus is defined as the projected accumulated
10		funds in the General Fund Investment Account resulting from the Nation's tribal
11		operations over the years, minus the Nation's tribal operating budget and tribal
12		supplemental appropriations, and including carryover funding appropriated
13		from the General Fund Investment Account. Resolution No. 09-267; and
14	WHEREAS,	the General Fund Surplus Reserve is currently at a zero balance; and
15	WHEREAS,	Resolution No. 09-267 provides that "[t]he General Fund Surplus Reserve
16		balance shall be replenished to an amount equal to 25% of the total amount of
17		the Nation's annual tribal operating budgets in accordance with a plan
18		developed by the Budget and Finance Committee and approved by Legislative
19		Council resolution."; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Budget and Finance Committee and the Nation's treasurer recommend that
21		the General Fund Surplus Reserve be replenished.
22	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that an
23		amount not to exceed 25% of the total amount appropriated by Legislative
24		Council resolution for FY 2017 tribal operating budgets is appropriated from
25		additional FY 2016 gaming revenues and FY 2017 Projected General Fund
26		Surplus to replenish the General Fund Surplus Reserve in accordance with
27		Resolution No. 09-267.
