

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2017 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets Under the Public Law 93-638  
Master Contract)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-326**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation ... and to  
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided  
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or  
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono  
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Executive Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY  
8 2017 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets under the Public Law 93-638 Master  
9 Contract, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of  
10 \$16,783,182.16 to be funded from the Nation's resources pending  
11 reimbursement from the grantor; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the following base budgets in the amount of \$16,460,364.16 have been prepared  
13 as follows:

19 **WHEREAS, the designated oversight Committees for their respective budgets and Budget**  
20 **and Finance Committee have reviewed the FY 2017 Bureau of Indian Affairs**  
21 **Budgets under the Public Law 93-638 Master Contract and recommend its**  
22 **approval.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 24 **1. Approves the FY 2017 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets under the Public**  
25 **Law 93-638 Master Contract effective October 1, 2016, in the total amount**  
26 **of \$16,783,182.16 which shall be funded from the Nation's resources**  
27 **pending reimbursement from the grantor, subject to negotiation and**  
28 **execution of annual funding agreements with the Bureau of Indian**  
29 **Affairs.**
- 30 **2. Directs that in the event of a federal Continuing Resolution, the**  
31 **programs shall limit spending to only essential program services,**

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1 functions and activities, and the Nation shall seek reimbursement of all  
2 funds the Nation expends for continuation of Bureau of Indian Affairs  
3 Programs performed pursuant to the Master Contract.

4 3. Authorizes the chairperson or any designated official to negotiate and  
5 execute the FY 2017 Annual Funding Agreement with the Bureau of  
6 Indian Affairs.

7 4. Authorizes the Tohono O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated  
8 official to administer and expend the FY 2017 Bureau of Indian Affairs  
9 Budgets, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be  
10 submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 26<sup>TH</sup>  
12 day of JULY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-  
13 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
14 Article VI, Section 1(d)(3)and(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
15 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
16 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
17 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
