

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving FY 2017 Planning and Economic Development, Roads Program**  
**Transportation Planning and Roads Inventory Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-344**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to  
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided  
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or  
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono  
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2017 Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads Program  
8 has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2017 Transportation  
9 Planning and Roads Inventory Budget, which is incorporated by this reference,  
10 in the amount of \$150,278.70 to be funded from the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees  
12 have reviewed the FY 2017 Planning and Economic Development Department,  
13 Roads Program Transportation Planning and Roads Inventory Budget and  
14 recommend its approval.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
16 FY 2017 Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads Program  
17 Transportation Planning and Roads Inventory Budget effective October 1, 2016  
18 in the amount of \$150,278.70, which shall be funded by the Bureau of Indian  
19 Affairs, and to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement from the  
20 grantor.

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono  
22 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to  
23 administer and expend the FY 2017 Planning and Economic Development  
24 Department, Roads Program Transportation Planning and Roads Inventory  
25 Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for  
26 prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

27 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28<sup>th</sup>  
28 day of JULY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,815.6 FOR; -0-  
29 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 205.8[07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
30 by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted  
31 by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy  
32 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
33 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
