

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety, Tribal Employment Rights**  
**Office WVR Administration Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-356**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to**  
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**  
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**  
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**  
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d) (2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety, Tribal Employment Rights Office has prepared**  
8 **and submitted for review and approval its FY 2017 Department of Public Safety,**  
9 **Tribal Employment Rights Office WVR Administration Budget, which is**  
10 **incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$223,227.21 to be funded from**  
11 **TERO Commission Revenue Fund; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and the Budget and Finance Committees**  
13 **have reviewed the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety, Tribal Employment**  
14 **Rights Office WVR Administration Budget and recommend its approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
16 **FY 2017 Department of Public Safety, Tribal Employment Rights Office WVR**  
17 **Administration Budget effective October 1, 2016 in the amount of \$223,227.21,**  
18 **which shall be funded by the TERO Commission Revenue Fund.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**  
20 **O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to**  
21 **administer and expend the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety, Tribal**  
22 **Employment Rights Office WVR Administration Budget, provided that any**  
23 **amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the**  
24 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28<sup>TH</sup>**  
26 **day of JULY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**  
31 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**






