

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2016 Chukut Kuk District-Horseshoe Ranch Community
Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 16-377

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,
3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the Tohono
5 O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by a treasurer
6 or other authorized officer of the district council who has furnished a surety
7 bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and all
8 expenditures of these funds shall be by checks signed by such treasurer or other
9 authorized officer and the chairman or vice chairman of the district council.

11 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council enacted Resolution No. 15-375
12 Approving FY 2016 Chukut Kuk District Budget; and

13 **WHEREAS,** Amendments to the FY 2016 Chukut Kuk District budget were approved by
14 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 15-480, 16-020 and 16-236;
15 and

16 **WHEREAS** the Chukut Kuk District Council enacted Resolution No. 2016-35 approving FY
17 2016 Horseshoe Ranch Community Budget Amendment No. 1 transferring
18 identified funds in the amount of \$1,200.00 to line item 780-Reserve for
19 Contingencies to cover anticipated costs and amending the budget justification;
20 and

21 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee did review Horseshoe Ranch Community FY
22 2016 Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommends its approval.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
24 FY 2016 Chukut Kuk District-Horseshoe Ranch Community Budget Amendment
25 No. 1 adding new language to line item 780-Reserve for Contingencies and does
26 not change the overall Chukut Kuk District Budget amount.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
28 District Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the
29 budget as attached provided that any amendments affecting the funds or

funding level of the FY 2016 Chukut Kuk District Budget shall be submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for prior approval.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 02ND day of AUGUST, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
