5		Power FM ("LPFM") application filing window in October 2013 to enable
6		communities to apply for noncommercial broadcasting licenses; and
7 WHE	REAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") submitted an application for a LPFM
8		license from the FCC that would allow for the provision of radio broadcast
9		coverage to satellite communities currently not covered by the Nation's existing
10		radio stations (Resolution No. 13-343); and
11 WHE	REAS,	on March 10, 2014, the Nation received notice from the FCC that it approved a
12		construction permit for KOHF-LP 101.1 FM radio tower/transmitter site ("Radio
13		Tower") for broadcast coverage within the Florence Community; and
14 WHE	REAS,	electrical service is needed for Radio Tower and Arizona Public Service ("APS") is
15		the most viable electrical utility provider; and
16 WHE	REAS,	in order to provide electrical service to the Radio Tower, APS will need to conduct
17		a land survey and obtain a right-of-way; and
18 WHE		federal regulations governing rights-of-way and surveys on tribal lands provide,
19		"[n]o right-of-way shall be granted over and across any tribal land, nor shall any
20		permission to survey be issued with respect to any such lands, without the prior
21		written consent of the tribe." (25 C.F.R. § 169.3); and
22 WHE	REAS,	the Nation's written consent is therefore required for APS to conduct a land
23		survey to identify a route to extend electrical service on the Radio Tower; and
24 WHE	REAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Cultural Preservation Committees
25		recommend that the Nation provide consent to APS to conduct a land survey to
26		identify a route to extend electrical service to the Radio Tower.
27 NOW	, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council provides
28		consent to APS to conduct a land survey to identify a route to extend electrical
29		service to the KOHF-LP radio tower/transmitter site in the Florence Community.
