

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2016 Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department
City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area—Native American Targeted
Investigation of Violent Enterprises Task Force Grant Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-406

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department**
8 **City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) – Native American**
9 **Targeted Investigation of Violent Enterprises Task Force (NATIVE) Grant**
10 **Agreement in the amount of \$84,500.00 was approved by Resolution No. 15-270;**
11 **and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department has received a Grant Agreement**
13 **Adjustment Notice for the HIDTA – NATIVE Grant reallocating funds within the**
14 **NATIVE task force; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department has**
16 **prepared HIDTA – NATIVE Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this**
17 **reference and which will (1) decrease the budget by \$30,137.00 from \$84,500.00 to**
18 **\$54,363.00 to reflect the grant award per the City of Tucson Grant Agreement**
19 **Adjustment Notice; and (2) delete all operational line items; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
21 **2016 Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department HIDTA –**
22 **NATIVE Grant Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
24 **FY 2016 Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department HIDTA**
25 **– NATIVE Budget Amendment No. 1 which will:**

- 26 **(1) Decrease the budget by \$30,137.00 from \$84,500.00 to \$54,363.00 to reflect**
27 **the grant award per the City of Tucson Grant Agreement Adjustment Notice.**
28 **(2) Delete all operational line items.**

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(Approving the FY 2016 Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area—Native American Targeted Investigation of Violent Enterprises Task Force Grant Budget Amendment No. 1)

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1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
3 expend the FY 2016 Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police
4 Department HIDTA - NATIVE Budget as amended, provided however, that any
5 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
6 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.


7 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH day**
8 **of AUGUST, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**
9 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
10 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
11 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
12 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
13 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
