

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between Pima County, for and on
behalf of the Pima County Forensic Science Center, and the Tohono O'odham
Nation for Medical Examiner Services)**

RESOLUTION NO. 16-407

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,**
2 **negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation ("Nation") with the Federal, State, and local governments..."**
4 **(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department desires the Nation to enter into**
6 **an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Pima County Forensic Science**
7 **Center for Medical Examiner Services; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council previously approved an IGA with Pima County for Medical**
9 **Examiner Services by Resolution No. 13-250; and**

10 **WHEREAS, Pima County would not enter into the IGA approved by Resolution No. 13-250**
11 **because it was only for a period of one year; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department has revised the IGA to be for a five**
13 **period to be effective thru September 30, 2021; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the Intergovernmental Agreement**
15 **and recommends its approval.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
17 **Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Pima**
18 **County, for and on behalf of the Pima County Forensic Science Center,**
19 **substantially in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairperson of the**
20 **Nation to execute it.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves amendments**
22 **to extend the term of the Intergovernmental Agreement from the time the IGA is**
23 **signed by both parties thru September 30, 2021, provided that amendments for**
24 **any other purpose shall be presented to the Legislative Council for review and**
25 **approval.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH day**
27 **of AUGUST, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
30 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
