

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2016 Administrative Lobby Budget Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-420**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Administrative Lobby Budget in the amount of \$785,745.00 was**  
8 **approved by Resolution No. 15-165; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Chairman has prepared and submitted for review and approval the**  
10 **FY 2016 Administrative Lobby Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by**  
11 **this reference and which increases line item 7336 Political Contributions and**  
12 **adjusting Operational line items; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Administrative Lobby Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase the**  
14 **Administrative Lobby Budget by \$150,000.00 to a new overall budget amount of**  
15 **\$935,745.00; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Appropriations and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**  
17 **2016 Administrative Lobby Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its**  
18 **approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
20 **FY 2016 Administrative Lobby Budget Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2015,**  
21 **which includes a \$150,000.00 increase from \$785,745.00 to \$935,745.00 that shall**  
22 **be funded by the Nation's surplus fund.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
24 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
25 **expend the FY 2016 Administrative Lobby Budget as amended, provided however,**  
26 **that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by**  
27 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22<sup>ND</sup> day**  
29 **of AUGUST, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**  
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


