

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2016 San Simon Community Mining Royalty Budget Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-425**

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
2 **Nation,**  
3 **No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets**  
4 **authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the Tohono**  
5 **O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by a treasurer**  
6 **or other authorized officer of the district council who has furnished a surety**  
7 **bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and all**  
8 **expenditures of these funds shall be by checks signed by such treasurer or other**  
9 **authorized officer and the chairman or vice chairman of the district council.**

11 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Pisinemo District Mining Royalty Budgets were approved by Tohono**  
12 **O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 16-017 in the amount of \$115,253.30;**  
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, the approved FY 2016 Pisinemo District Mining Royalty Budgets included a**  
15 **budget for San Simon Community Mining Royalty in the amount of \$10,000.00;**  
16 **and**

17 **WHEREAS, which was amended by Pisinemo District Council Resolution No. 16-P-26 the**  
18 **Pisinemo District has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY**  
19 **2016 San Simon Community Mining Royalty Budget Amendment No. 1 which is**  
20 **incorporated by this reference and which (1) increases and decreases Line**  
21 **Items; 727 - Materials, 766-Client Support, 852-Donations and Contributions,**  
22 **and 865-Emergency Assistance and (2) adding new Line Item 854-Clothing**  
23 **Allowance; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2016 San Simon**  
25 **Community Mining Royalty Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommends its**  
26 **approval.**

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
28 **FY 2016 San Simon Community Mining Royalty Budget Amendment No. 1 as**  
29 **attached.**

30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this amendment will add a new language to Line Item 810-**  
31 **Professional Services and it will not change the original budgeted amount of**  
32 **\$10,000.00 of the FY 2016 San Simon Community Mining Royalty Budget nor will**

1 it change the overall budgeted amount for the FY 2016 Pisinemo District Mining  
2 Royalty Budget of \$115,253.30.

3 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2016 San  
4 Simon Community Mining Royalty Budget Amendment No. 1 as amended shall  
5 be managed and expended in accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the  
6 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that  
7 any amendments or modifications shall be authorized under District Council  
8 resolution and submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
9 Council.

10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup>  
11 day of SEPTEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4  
12 FOR; ~~-0-~~ AGAINST; ~~-0-~~ NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
13 Council by Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
14 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
15 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
16 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).




