

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Planning and Economic Development Department's Roads Program
Request to adopt the Tohono O'odham Transportation Safety Plan to enhance
safety on the Tohono O'odham Nation's Roads)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-427

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council**
2 **with the power "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,**
3 **morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham nation and its**
4 **members." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has roadways on the BIA Indian Reservation Roads**
6 **inventory that have design elements such as high speed limits, narrow lane**
7 **widths and shoulders, deep ditches, and other significant unsafe conditions that**
8 **increase the risk of fatalities and serious injuries on the Tohono O'odham**
9 **Nation Roads; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Transportation Safety Plan can be an effective tool for**
11 **saving lives and reducing injuries on the Tohono O'odham Nation's roadways by**
12 **providing a proactive approach to addressing roadway safety issues; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Transportation Safety Plan is a multi-disciplinary**
14 **approach to safety by developing more effective solutions and leveraging**
15 **resources through consideration and coordination of the 4E's which are**
16 **Engineering, Enforcement, Education, and Emergency Services Strategies; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Transportation Safety Plan provides direction in**
18 **developing a prioritized list of improvements to better justify funding requests**
19 **by documenting specific needs that are consistent with the emphasis areas and**
20 **strategies listed in the Plan; and**

21 **WHEREAS, MAP-21, the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (P.L. 112-141),**
22 **requires coordination of other plans and programs with the State Highway**
23 **Safety Plan, so the Tohono O'odham Transportation Safety Plan has been**
24 **developed based on the applicable emphasis areas and strategies contained in**
25 **the Arizona State Highway Safety Plan; and**

26 **WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee of the Legislative Council**
27 **have reviewed the proposed Tohono O'odham Transportation Safety Plan for the**
28 **Tohono O'odham Nation and recommend its approval.**

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council**
2 **hereby approves the Tribal Transportation Safety Plan for the Tohono O'odham**
3 **Nation.**

4 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council hereby directs**
5 **the Planning and Economic Development Department-Roads Program to**
6 **present an annual report to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council detailing**
7 **the implementation and performance of the Tohono O'odham Transportation**
8 **Safety Plan.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH**
10 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4**
11 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
12 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
13 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
14 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**
15 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
