| 1 | WHEREAS, | by Resolution No. 02-562, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") approved a new |
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| 2 | | tribal-state gaming compact ("Compact") with the State of Arizona; and |
| 3 | WHEREAS, | pursuant to Section 12 of the Compact, the Nation agreed to make certain tribal |
| 4 | | contributions in consideration for substantial exclusivity covenants by the |
| 5 | | State, and pursuant to Section 12(d), the Nation agreed to contribute 12% of its |
| 6 | | total annual contribution (the "12% Distribution") to cities, towns, and counties, |
| 7 | | for services that benefit the general public; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, | pursuant to Section 12(e)(2) of the Compact the 12% Distribution disbursement |
| 9 | | shall be transmitted to the recipient no later than sixty (60) days after the last |
| 10 | | day of the Gaming Facility Operator's fiscal year; and |
| 11 | WHEREAS, | Section 7(d) of the Gaming Enterprise Charter, 16 T.O.C. Chapter 2, directs the |
| 12 | | Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise to "timely pay the contribution required |
| 13 | | under Section 12(d) of the Compact in accordance with the directives of the |
| 14 | | Legislative Council. The Enterprise shall comply with all accounting, auditing, |
| 15 | | and record keeping requirements and obligations of the Nation under the |
| 16 | | Compact relating to the payment of regulatory costs and tribal contributions as |
| 17 | | required under Section 12 of the Compact."; and |
| 18 | WHEREAS, | the Commerce Committee and the Chairman of the Nation recommend that the |
| 19 | | Legislative Council approve awards to grantees for the designated purposes and |
| 20 | | in the amounts appearing on the 2016 12% Distribution List, which is |
| 21 | | incorporated by this reference. |
| 22 | NOW, THERE | FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves |
| 23 | | payments to the listed grantees for the purposes identified in the 2016 12% |
| 24 | ! | Distribution List, which shall remain confidential and shall not be reported or |
| 25 | | disclosed; provided that information concerning individual awards may be |
| 26 | | released without disclosing the total amount of the 2016 12% Distribution. |
| 27 | BE IT FURTH | ER RESOLVED that if the designated grantees are unable to receive and expend |
| 28 | | the 12% Distribution in accordance with this resolution and the Compact, the |
| 29 | | Commerce Committee and Nation's Chairperson are authorized to jointly |
| 30 | | approve amendments to 2016 12% Distribution List awards that are made |
| 31 | | exclusively to the grantees identified in the 2016 12% Distribution List, that are |

(Approving Grantees for the Disbursement of the FY2016 Gaming Compact Section 12(d) 12% Contribution) Page 2 of 3 1 solely for purposes permitted under Section 12(d) of the Compact, and that 2 collectively do not exceed 10% of the total Distribution amount. 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation's Chairperson and Commerce Committee are 4 authorized to jointly approve grantees' requests to spend unused remaining 5 funds identified in the 2016 12% Distribution List, that are solely for purposes 6 permitted under Section 12(d) of the Compact and that fall within the scope of 7 work identified in the grantee's proposal as approved by Council. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the 8 9 Chairman of the Nation to execute grant agreements with the grantees as 10 necessary in accordance with the 2016 12% Distribution List and the terms of 11 this resolution.
