| 1 | WHEREAS, | the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham |

| 11 | WHEREAS, | sovereign Indian tribes share a unique trust relationship with the United States |

| 15 | WHEREAS, | the United States government has legal and moral responsibilities to manage |
| 16 | | traditional cultural territories in a way that shows respect for cultural, historical, |

| 18 | WHEREAS, | against strong opposition by the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe, Dakota Access, LLC |
| 19 | | has proposed construction of a \$3.7 billion, 1,168-mile-long pipeline (the "Dakota |
| 20 | | Access Pipeline") that will transfer up to 570,000 barrels of crude oil per day, and |
| 21 | | would cross the Missouri River less than a mile away from the Standing Rock |
| 22 | į | Reservation homelands, posing high risk to the ancestral sites of the Standing |
| 23 | | Rock Sioux and its water supply; and |
| 24 | WHEREAS, | for several months, tribal members and supporters have occupied a camp set up |
| 25 | | by the Standing Rock Sioux at the confluence of the Cannonball and Missouri |
| 26 | | Rivers to protest construction of the pipeline, and to date over 85 tribal nations |
| 27 | | have voiced support of Standing Rock Sioux Tribe's opposition; and |
| 28 | WHEREAS, | the process used in obtaining permits for the Dakota Access Pipeline project has |
| 29 | | circumvented federal laws mandating protections of Native American culture |
| 30 | | and environment and violates Executive Order 13175 "Consultation and |
| 31 | | Coordination with Indian Tribal Governments" and subsequent presidential |
