1	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is exclusively vested the authority to conduct removal
2		upon accusation proceedings when a Nation's official is accused of committing a
3		removable offense (Constitution, Article XIII); and
4	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is further authorized to "establish rules and procedures
5		to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution, Article VI,
6		Section 1(a)); and
7	WHEREAS,	as the Tohono O'odham Judicial Court has recognized, removal upon accusation
8		hearings are uniquely legislative and political in nature and the Council is
9		exclusively vested with the authority to adopt removal hearing procedures
10		(Francisco v. Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Case No. 89-M-
11		4592 (March 7, 1989)); and
12	WHEREAS,	on August 11, 2016 an accusation for removal from office was filed with the
13		Judiciary Committee Chairperson by a registered voter of the Tohono O'odham
14		Nation against Chairman Rodrick Manuel and Vice Chairwoman Angelita Castillo
15		(the "Accused') in accordance with the provisions of Section 11002, Article X of the
16		Nation's Elections law, 12 T.O.C. Chapter 1; and
17	WHEREAS,	pursuant to the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and Nation's
18		Elections law, the Accused were provided with written disclosures, were
19		represented by legal counsel, and were given the opportunity to subpoena, call,
20		and question witnesses, testify, make an opening statement and closing
21		argument, file motions, make objections, present evidence, and otherwise
22		answer the Accusation; and
23	WHEREAS,	following the closed reasonable cause hearing, a majority of the Judiciary
24		Committee present determined there is reasonable cause to believe that each of
25		the Accused committed removable offenses as charged in the Accusation; and
26	WHEREAS,	pursuant to 12 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Section 11002(C), the Judiciary Committee filed
27		the accusation with the Council secretary, together with a copy of the Judiciary
28		Committee resolutions supporting its determination; and
29	WHEREAS,	pursuant to 12 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Section 11002(D), "Upon the filing of the
30		accusation and committee resolution as provided in paragraph (C), the secretary
31		of the Council shall cause a copy of the accusation and any removal hearing
32		procedures to be served on the accused with copies to the accuser(s), and require

(Adopting Amended "Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Removal Hearing Procedures" and **Setting Removal Hearing)** Page 2 of 2 1 by written notice of not less than ten days that the accused appear before the 2 Council and answer the accusation": and 3 WHEREAS. the Legislative Council previously adopted the "Tohono O'odham Legislative 4 Council Removal Hearing Procedures," by Legislative Order No. 14-104 to govern 5 removal proceedings before the Council, and the Legislative Rules Committee 6 has drafted amended Procedures dated for reference September 14, 2016, which 7 are incorporated by this reference, to further clarify the removal process; and 8 WHEREAS. the Council officers and Rules Committee recommend that the Council conduct a 9 removal hearing on September 27-28, 2016 at the Legislative Council chambers in 10 Sells.
