

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Executive Branch Veteran's Affairs Office Budget Amendment No. 2)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-456

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to**
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Executive Branch Veteran's Affairs Office Budget in the amount of**
8 **\$117,976.31 was approved by Resolution No. 15-165; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Executive Branch Veteran's Affairs Office Budget Amendment No.1**
10 **was approved by Resolution No. 16-034 which increased the budget amount to**
11 **\$118,476.31; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch Veteran's Affairs Office has prepared and submitted for**
13 **review and approval its FY 2016 Budget Amendment No. 2, which is incorporated**
14 **by this reference and which creates line item 7050 Firearms & Taser; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the FY 2016 Executive Branch Veteran's Affairs Office Amendment No. 2 will**
16 **increase the Executive Branch FY 2016 Veteran's Affairs Office Budget by**
17 **\$5,000.00 from \$118,476.31 to \$123,476.31; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have**
19 **reviewed the FY 2016 Executive Branch Veteran's Affairs Office Budget**
20 **Amendment No. 2 and recommend its approval.**


21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
22 **FY 2016 Executive Branch Veteran's Affairs Office Budget Amendment No. 2,**
23 **which includes a \$5,000.00 increase from \$118,476.31 to \$123,476.31 that shall be**
24 **funded by the Nation's surplus fund.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**
26 **O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to**
27 **administer and expend the FY 2016 Executive Branch Veteran's Affairs Office**
28 **Budget as amended, provided however, that any amendments or modifications**
29 **shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
30 **Council.**

31 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH**
32 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,792.8**
33 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 228.6[10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
34 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
35 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
36 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**
37 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**

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
