

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2016 Pisinemo District Operations Budget Amendment No. 2)**

RESOLUTION NO. 16-463

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approve by the
5 Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only
6 by a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has
7 furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono
8 O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks
9 signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or
10 vice chairman of the district council.

12 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2016 Pisinemo District Budgets in the amount of \$1,615,811.13 were
13 approved by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 15-378; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the approved FY 2016 Pisinemo District Budgets included a budget for District
15 Operations which was amended by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
16 Resolution No. 16-133 for Amendment No. 1; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Pisinemo District Administration has prepared and submitted for review and
18 approval its FY 2016 Pisinemo District Operations Budget Amendment No. 2
19 which is incorporated by this reference which increases Salaries line item and
20 decrease Fringe Benefits line item; and

21 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the budget and recommends its
22 approval.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
24 FY 2016 Pisinemo District Operations Budget Amendment No. 2 as attached with
25 no change to the original budgeted amount of the FY 2016 Pisinemo District
26 Budgets of \$1,615,811.13.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2016 Pisinemo
28 District Operations Budget as amended shall be managed and expended in
29 accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
30 Nation and Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or modifications shall
31 be authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior approval
32 by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH day of SEPTEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,654.2 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 367.2 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
