

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the FY 2017 Sif-Oidak District Budgets)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-471**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council enacted Resolution No. 16-368,**  
2 **"Approving FY 2017 District Allocation and Apportionment of Gaming Revenues**  
3 **to Districts by Equal Distribution"; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the apportionment for Sif-Oidak District is in the amount of \$2,178,486.42 and is**  
5 **made available for expenditure subject to an approved budget in accordance**  
6 **with Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and Article IX, Section 7 of the Nation's**  
7 **Constitution; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Sif-Oidak District Council enacted Resolution No. SODC 16-119, "Approving**  
9 **the FY 2017 Sif-Oidak District Budget in the Amount of \$2,178,486.42; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the**  
11 **FY17 Sif Oidak District Budgets and recommends its approval.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
13 **approves the FY 2017 Sif-Oidak District Budgets in the amount of \$2,178,486.42,**  
14 **as attached and authorizes expenditure of funds for:**

25 **budget as attached provided that any amendments/modifications affecting the**  
26 **funds or funding level of the FY 2017 Sif Oidak District Budgets shall be**  
27 **submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for prior approval.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16<sup>TH</sup>**  
29 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4**  
30 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
31 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**  
32 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
33 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**  
34 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
