

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the FY 17 Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono  
O'odham Nation and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc.)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-494**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative**  
2 **Council with the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and**  
3 **contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local**  
4 **governments and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or**  
5 **political subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters**  
6 **within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI,**  
7 **Section 1(f)); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
9 **("Nation") and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc.**  
10 **("Intermountain") will allow Intermountain to provide residential and foster**  
11 **care services for the Nation's Children In Need of Care for the period of October**  
12 **1, 2016 to September 30, 2017; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Professional Services Agreement is in excess of \$500,000.00; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the agreement and**  
15 **recommends its approval.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
17 **FY 17 Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and**  
18 **Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc., and that the Tohono**  
19 **O'odham Nation Chairperson is authorized to execute the Professional Services**  
20 **Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29<sup>TH</sup>**  
22 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,794.9**  
23 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 226.5 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
24 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2), 1(d)(3), and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
25 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the**  
26 **Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
27 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
