

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Department of Health and Human Services Division of
Community Health Services Public Health Emergency Preparedness and
Response Grant Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 16-496

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services Division of Community Health
8 Services has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2017 Public
9 Health Preparedness and Response Grant Budget, which is incorporated by this
10 reference, in the amount of \$76,315.19 to be funded by the Arizona Department
11 of Health Services; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have
13 reviewed the FY 2017 Department of Health and Human Services Division of
14 Community Health Services Public Health Preparedness and Response Grant
15 Budget and recommend its approval.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
17 FY 2017 Department of Health and Human Services Division of Community
18 Health Services Public Health Preparedness and Response Grant Budget
19 effective July 1, 2016 in the amount of \$76,315.19 which shall be funded by the
20 Arizona Department of Health Services Public Health Emergency Preparedness
21 and Response Grant of \$43,338.00 and a FY 2016 carryover of \$32,977.19.

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono
23 O'odham Nation Chairperson or any designated official is authorized to
24 administer and expend the FY 2017 Department of Health and Human Services
25 Division of Community Health Services Public Health Preparedness and
26 Response Grant Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall
27 be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29TH**
29 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,794,9**
30 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 226.5 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
31 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
32 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
33 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**
34 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


