

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Sanitation Facilities Deficiency System Priority Ranking)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-514**

1 **WHEREAS, Indian Health Service, Division of Environmental Health and Engineering**  
2 **(DEH&E) conducts and assessment of Sanitation Facilities Deficiencies,**  
3 **annually; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does have an**  
5 **impact upon congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Indian Health Service has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4)**  
7 **most critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall**  
8 **prioritization of projects; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided**  
10 **recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council regarding the**  
11 **most critical needs.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has**  
13 **reviewed and approved the entire priority list and has determined that**  
14 **following deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending**  
15 **order of prioritization:**

- 16 1. San Xavier West Uranium
- 17 2. Sells Sewer Main/Lagoon Upgrade Phase 2
- 18 3. Sells Open Dump Closures - Sells #7, #8, #9
- 19 4. Little Tucson/Artesian Trunk Replacement

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19<sup>TH</sup>**  
21 **day of OCTOBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,523.45 FOR;**  
22 **1,165.85 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 332.1[04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
23 **Council by Article VI, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**  
24 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
25 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
26 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**




