

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Department of Education, Recreation Division Budget
Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 16-519

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY2017 Department of Education, Recreation Division Budget in the amount
8 of \$2,872,522.90 was approved by Resolution No. 16-322; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Education, Recreation Division has prepared and submitted
10 for review and approval its FY 2017 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is
11 incorporated by this reference and which (1) will adjust operational line items;
12 (2) add new line item 7500 - Major Capital Equipment; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2017 Department of Education, Recreation Division Budget Amendment
14 No. 1 will not increase the overall budgeted amount of \$2,872,522.90; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
16 reviewed the FY 2017 Department of Education, Recreation Division Budget
17 Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
19 FY 2017 Department of Education, Recreation Division Budget Amendment No. 1
20 which will add a new line item 7500 Major Capital Equipment with no increase to
21 the overall budgeted amount of \$2,872,522.90.

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono
23 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to
24 administer and expend the FY 2017 Department of Education, Recreation
25 Division Budget as amended, provided however, that any amendments or
26 modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
27 Legislative Council.

28 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH
29 day of OCTOBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR;
30 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
31 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
32 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
33 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
34 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
