

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2017 Self-Governance Budgets)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-524

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services, Department of Public Safety,
8 Department of Information and Technology, Facility Management Program, and
9 Planning and Economic Development Department have prepared and
10 submitted for review and approval their FY 2017 Self-Governance Budgets for
11 the period beginning October 1, 2016 and ending on September 30, 2017
12 (collectively, "FY 2017 Self-Governance Budgets"), and as identified in FY 2017
13 Self-Governance Budgets Schedule, which are incorporated by this reference, in
14 the total amounts of:

15 Department of Health and Human Services \$92,201,034.95

16 Department of Public Safety-Health Care Center Security \$1,227,569.83

17 Department of Information and Technology-Third Party \$659,700.84

18 Facility Management Program- \$5,078,695.36

19 Planning and Economic Development Department - \$2,174,424.06; and

20 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 16-308, as affirmed by Resolution No. 16-487, the Legislative
21 Council established the Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care Governing Body
22 and made it "legally responsible for the conduct of the Tohono O'odham Nation
23 Health Care" to "carry out the functions specified 42 CFR Part 482 that pertain to
24 the Governing Body"; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the Governing Body is therefore legally responsible in accordance with 42 CFR
26 Part 482(d)(1) for an institutional plan that "must include an annual operating
27 budget"; and

28 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services, Domestic Affairs, and Budget and Finance
29 Committees of the Legislative Council have reviewed the FY 2017 Self-
30 Governance Budgets and recommend approval.

31 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves
32 the FY 2017 Self-Governance Budgets for the:

33 Department of Health and Human Services \$92,201,034.95;

34 Department of Public Safety-Health Care Center Security \$1,227,569.83;

35 Department of Information and Technology-Third Party \$659,700.84;

1 Facility Management Program-\$5,078,695.36; and
2 Planning and Economic Development Department-\$2,174,424.06;
3 effective October 1, 2016 in the total amount of \$101,341,425.04, which shall be
4 funded by the Indian Health Services and third party revenues.

5 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation Chairperson or any designated official is authorized to
7 administer and expend the FY 2017 Self-Governance Budgets provided, that the
8 Governing Body shall approve any amendments or modifications, subject to
9 final approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 26TH
11 day of OCTOBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR;
12 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
13 Article II, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
14 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
15 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
16 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


