

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Recessing November 16, 2016 General Session at 12:00 P.M.)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 16-545

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power 'to establish rules and procedures**
2 **to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees,**
3 **boards and special committees" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
4 **Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Article I, Section 1(B)(4) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
6 **Council provides that "[e]ach legislative general, special, or emergency session**
7 **shall commence at 9:00 a.m. and end no later than 5:00 p.m. ..."; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee requests that Council recess the**
9 **Wednesday, November 16, 2016 general session at 12:00 p.m. to allow respective**
10 **oversight committees to meet and address self-governance issues.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**
12 **November 16, 2016 general session shall recess at 12:00 p.m. to allow respective**
13 **oversight committees to meet and address self-governance issues.**


14 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH day of**
15 **NOVEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,460.7 FOR; 340.8**
16 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 219.9[07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
17 **by Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
18 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
19 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
20 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
