**RESOLUTION NO. 16-559**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to**  
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**  
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**  
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**  
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety was awarded the 2016 United States**  
8 **Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice**  
9 **Assistance (BJA), Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) (Award**  
10 **Number 2016DJBX0985) in the amount of \$12,142.00; and**

11 **WHEREAS, this award is effective October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2017; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**  
13 **approval its FY 2017 DOJ, OJP, BJA, Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Project Budget**  
14 **in the amount of \$12,142.00, which is incorporated by this reference; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget and Finance Committee have**  
16 **reviewed the 2016 US DOJ, OJP, BJA, Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Award (Number**  
17 **2016DJBX0985) and the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety DOJ, OJP, BJA,**  
18 **Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Project Budget and recommend their approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the**  
20 **2016 US DOJ, OJP, BJA, Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Award (Number**  
21 **2016DJBX0985), effective October 1, 2015 thru September 30, 2017, and approves**  
22 **the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety DOJ, OJP, BJA, Edward Byrne Memorial**  
23 **JAG Project Budget in the amount of \$12,142.00 that shall be funded by the**  
24 **Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**  
26 **O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to**  
27 **administer and expend the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety US DOJ, OJP,**  
28 **BJA, Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Project Budget, provided however, that any**



8 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
9 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
