

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police**  
**Department United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement,**  
**Homeland Security Investigations Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-560**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to**  
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**  
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**  
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**  
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department has**  
8 **entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the United States**  
9 **Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), Homeland Security Investigations**  
10 **(HSI) Special Agent in Charge (SAC) Phoenix which was approved by Resolution**  
11 **No. 15-446; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the MOU allows for reimbursement of overtime costs and other costs incurred**  
13 **by officer(s) assigned as members of the designated joint operations with the ICE**  
14 **SAC Phoenix; and**

15 **WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Police Department is responsible for fringe benefits for**  
16 **the overtime hours requested for reimbursement to be funded by the FY 2017**  
17 **Tribal Law Enforcement Budget; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department has prepared and submitted for review**  
19 **and approval its FY 2017 United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement,**  
20 **Homeland Security Investigations Budget, which is incorporated by this**  
21 **reference, in the amount of \$60,000.00; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**  
23 **2017 Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department United**  
24 **States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Homeland Security**  
25 **Investigations Budget and recommend its approval.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
27 **FY 2017 Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department**  
28 **United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Homeland Security**

2                   be funded by the FY 2017 Tribal Law Enforcement Budget.


3       BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono

5       administer and expend the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety, Tohono  
6       O'odham Police Department United States Immigration and Customs  
7       Enforcement, Homeland Security Investigations Budget, provided that any  
8       amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the  
9       Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

10       The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18<sup>TH</sup>  
11       day of NOVEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR;  
12       -0- AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
13       by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted  
14       by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy  
15       Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
16       Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


