

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Accepting U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention,**  
**Youth Mentoring Program Three-Month No-Cost Grant Extension and Approving FY 2017**  
**Department of Public Safety Youth Mentoring Program Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-596**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to**  
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**  
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**  
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**  
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") was awarded a U.S. Department of Justice**  
8 **("DOJ"), Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention ("OJJDP") Youth**  
9 **Mentoring Program grant, Award No. 2011-TX-FX-0010, effective October 1, 2011**  
10 **through September 30, 2014, which was accepted by Tohono O'odham**  
11 **Legislative Council Resolution No. 11-541; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Nation requested and received from the DOJ OJJDP a 12-month no-cost grant**  
13 **extension to extend the budget period from October 1, 2014 to September 30,**  
14 **2015, which was accepted by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No.**  
15 **14-476; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Nation requested and received from the DOJ OJJDP a second 12-month no-**  
17 **cost grant extension to extend the budget period from October 1, 2015 to**  
18 **September 30, 2016, which was accepted by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
19 **Resolution No. 15-357; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Nation requested and received from the DOJ OJJDP a third no-cost grant**  
21 **extension to extend the budget period for three-months from October 1, 2016**  
22 **through December 31, 2016; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety ("DPS") prepared and submitted for review and**  
24 **approval its FY 2017 Youth Mentoring Program Budget, which is incorporated by**  
25 **this reference, in the amount of \$41,360.63, which shall be funded by the DOJ**  
26 **OJJDP; and**

27 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**  
28 **FY 2017 DPS Youth Mentoring Program Budget and recommend its approval.**

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the  
2 DOJ OJJDP Youth Mentoring Program three-month no-cost grant extension to  
3 extend the budget period from October 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2017  
5 DPS Youth Mentoring Program Budget, effective October 1, 2016, in the amount  
6 of \$41,360.63 that shall be funded by the DOJ OJJDP.

7 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono  
8 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to  
9 administer and expend the FY 2017 DPS Youth Mentoring Program Budget,  
10 provided however, that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted to  
11 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for prior approval.

12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup>  
13 day of DECEMBER, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR;  
14 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
15 Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
16 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
17 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
18 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
