

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Setting May 3, 2017 General Session for a Tour of Economic Development Authority  
Properties)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 17-148**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and  
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing  
3 committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono  
4 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** Article I, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
6 Council, as amended, provides that "[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be  
7 held at the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells,  
8 Tohono O'odham Nation, with the following exceptions. . . [a] majority of all the  
9 legislative representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other than  
10 the chambers located at Sells."; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Commerce Committee has requested the Legislative Council set its May 3,  
12 2017 general session for a tour of Economic Development Authority properties  
13 with roll call beginning at 5:30 a.m. in Council chambers.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the May 3,  
15 2017 general session shall be set for a tour of Economic Development Authority  
16 properties with roll call beginning at 5:30 a.m. in Council chambers.

17 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup> day of**  
18 **APRIL 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
19 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**  
20 **Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**  
21 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian**  
22 **Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
23 **Stat.984).**
