LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 17-236

1	WHEREAS,	Article V, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation provides
2		that votes cast by Legislative Council representatives shall be apportioned as
3		follows:
4		Each district shall be entitled to as many votes on the Tohono
5		O'odham Council (divided by ten) as there are members of the
6		Tohono O'odham Nation residing in the district. Such votes may
7		be cast by either or both of the district representatives, or their
8		alternates, who are present and voting.
9		; and
10	WHEREAS,	pursuant to 12 T.O.C. Chapter 1 - Elections, Section 1801(B) "Certification of
11		District Residents: It shall be the duty of the Board to certify from the official
12		Membership Roll of the Nation, the number of members of the Nation residing
13		in each district, and the number of votes each district is entitled to cast at the
14		Council in accordance with Article V, Section 2 of the Constitution."; and
15	WHEREAS,	on May 27, 2017 the Tohono O'odham Election Board conducted a general
16		election for the representatives and alternates to the Tohono O'odham
17		Legislative Council and district councils; and
18	WHEREAS,	on May 28, 2017 the Election Board issued its Certificates of Election Results in
19		accordance with 12 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Section 1806(J); and
20	WHEREAS,	the Election Board certified and posted its certificate of district residents and
21		district votes, entitled "Certification of District Residence," [sic] dated May 28,
22		2017, apportioning the number of votes each district is entitled to cast on the
23		Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (Elections, Section 1801(B)); and
24	WHEREAS,	on June 12, 2017, the Election Board issued a "Corrected Certification of District
25		Residents," correcting the word "RESIDENCE" to "RESIDENTS" in the title of the
26		Certification, which is incorporated by this reference; and
27	WHEREAS,	the number of Legislative Council votes apportioned and certified by the
28		Election Board in its "Certification of District Residents" totals 3084.6; and
29	WHEREAS,	the five-day period for appealing the number of votes given to each district by
30		the Election Board has expired and no such appeal has been filed.
31	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the
32		apportionment of votes each district is entitled to cast on the Tohono O'odham

Chapter 1 – Elections

The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16TH day of JUNE, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article V, Section 2 and Article VI, Section 1(g) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
