2		the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,						
3		education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"						
4		(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and						
5	WHEREAS,	Indian Health Service, Division of Environmental Health and Engineering						
6		("DEH&E") conducts an annual assessment of sanitation facilities deficiencies;						
7		and						
8	WHEREAS,	the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does have an						
9		impact upon congressional appropriations and Indian Health Service allocation						
10		of funds; and						
11	WHEREAS,	Indian Health Service has provided for tribal priority ranking of four of the most						
12		critical projects and allocates points impacting upon overall prioritization of						
13		projects; and						
14	WHEREAS,	the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided						
15		recommendations to the Health and Human Services Committee regarding the						
16		most critical needs; and						
17	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the priority ranking of						
18		sanitation facilities deficiencies from the Division of Environmental Health and						
19		Engineering and recommends Council approval.						
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed							
21	and approved the following priority ranking of sanitation facilities deficiencies							
22	and has determined that the following deficiencies are the four most critical and							
23	desirable, in descending order of prioritization:							
24		1. Charco 27 & San Xavier Open Dump Closures						
25	2. San Xavier West Uranium							
26		3. Modular Bathroom – Water & Sewer – Group 2 (Sites 26-38)						
27		4. San Xavier West Sewer Upgrades (Trust Land).
