

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving a 12 Month Extension of the U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services ("COPS") Technology Program Award No. 2010CKWX0333 and Approving the FY 2018 Department of Public Safety U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services, Technology Program Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-574**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to**  
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**  
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**  
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**  
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department was**  
8 **awarded the U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services**  
9 **("COPS") Technology Program Award No. 2010CKWX0333 in the amount of**  
10 **\$100,000.00, which was accepted by Legislative Council Resolution No. 11-096;**  
11 **and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department applied**  
13 **for and has been awarded four grant extensions, which have been approved by**  
14 **Legislative Council Resolutions No. 13-025, 14-329, 15-266, and 17-188,**  
15 **respectively; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Police Department requested**  
17 **and has been approved for a fifth and final extension from the U.S. Department**  
18 **of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, which extension is a**  
19 **12 month no-cost extension for the grant period of June 16, 2017 through June**  
20 **15, 2018; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the grant does not allow for Indirect Costs; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**  
23 **approval its FY 2018 U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing**  
24 **Services Technology Program Budget, which is incorporated by this reference,**  
25 **in the amount of \$100,000.00 to be funded from the Nation's General Fund**  
26 **pending reimbursement by the grantor; and**

27 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**  
28 **2018 Department of Public Safety U.S. Department of Justice, Community**  
29 **Oriented Policing Services Technology Program Award No. 2010CKWX0333**  
30 **extension and the associated FY 2018 Department of Public Safety U.S.**  
31 **Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services Technology**  
32 **Program Budget and recommend their approval.**

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
2 fifth, and final, 12 month extension of the U.S. Department of Justice,  
3 Community Oriented Policing Services ("COPS") Technology Program Award No.  
4 2010CKWX0333 for the grant period of June 16, 2017 through June 15, 2018.

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2018  
6 Department of Public Safety U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented  
7 Policing Services Technology Program Budget in the amount of \$100,000.00  
8 effective October 1, 2017, which shall be funded by the Nation's General Fund  
9 pending reimbursement by the grantor.

10 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono  
11 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to  
12 administer and expend the FY 2018 Department of Public Safety U.S.  
13 Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services Technology  
14 Program Budget, provided however, that any amendments or modifications  
15 shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
16 Council.

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27<sup>TH</sup>**  
18 **day of NOVEMBER, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR;**  
19 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
20 **Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2)(3) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**  
21 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
22 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
23 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
