RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approving a Limited Waiver of the Sovereign Immunity of the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise in Favor of Hunt-PENTA West Valley Resort)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-614

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") is a federally recognized Indian tribe
2		organized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18,
3		1934 (48 Stat. 984; 25 U.S.C. § 476), which exercises sovereignty over both its
4		members and its lands; and
5	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Article VI of the Nation's Constitution, the Tohono O'odham
6		Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is vested with all of the legislative
7		powers of the Nation and is empowered to enact laws, ordinances, and
8		resolutions necessary or incidental to the exercise of its legislative powers; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council of the Nation has enacted an Ordinance for the
10		Regulation of Gaming Activities Within the Tohono O'odham Nation (the
11		"Gaming Ordinance"), which ordinance was adopted pursuant to Resolution No.
12		93-296 and amended by Resolution No. 97-150, Resolution No. 97-168, Resolution
13		No. 97-303, Resolution No. 99-206, Resolution No. 03-084, and Resolution No. 07-
14		300 (16 T.O.C. Chapter 1); and
15	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Ordinance provides that all gaming activities conducted within the
16		Nation shall be owned entirely by the Nation and conducted and operated by a
17		tribal enterprise; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise (the "Gaming Enterprise") is a tribal
19		governmental enterprise of the Nation established pursuant to Article VI of the
20		Nation's Constitution as the tribal enterprise responsible for operating the
21		Nation's gaming facilities and conducting gaming activities in compliance with
22		the requirements of the Gaming Ordinance; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council adopted the Charter of the Gaming Enterprise (the
24		"Charter") by Resolution No. 93-311 and amended the Charter by Resolution No.
25		02-294, Resolution No. 03-231, Resolution No. 04-513, Resolution No. 15-062, and
26		Resolution No. 17-408 (16 T.O.C. Chapter 2); and
27	WHEREAS,	Section 5(d)(3) of the Charter charges the Gaming Enterprise with the
28		responsibility for planning, constructing, and management of all new or
29		additional gaming facilities; and
30	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Enterprise Management Board is authorized to enter into, make,
31		perform and carry out contracts for any lawful purpose pertaining to the
32		Enterprise's business (Charter, Section 5(d)(10)); and
33	WHEREAS,	Section 8(b)(2) of the Charter provides for a limited waiver of the Gaming
34		Enterprise's sovereign immunity with respect to claims based upon a written

1		contract to which the Gaming Enterprise is a party and reserves to the
2		Legislative Council "the power to prospectively modify this limited waiver of the
3		Enterprise's immunity either generally or with respect to particular
4		circumstances." (Charter, Section 8(b)(2) and 8(c)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Enterprise has entered into a Master Agreement for Pre
6		Construction Services ("Pre-Con Agreement") on August 25, 2017 with Hunt-
7		PENTA West Valley Resort ("Hunt-PENTA"), a joint venture of Hunt Construction
8		Group, Inc., an Indiana corporation, and The PENTA Building Group, LLC, a
9		Nevada limited liability company, for the purpose of engaging Hunt-PENTA as
10		construction consultant for the development and construction of TOGE's West
11		Valley Resort gaming facility on the Nation's lands located near Glendale, AZ;
12		and
13	WHEREAS,	TOGE also entered into a Master Construction Agreement ("Construction
14		Agreement") with Hunt-PENTA on November 1, 2017 for the purpose of engaging
15		Hunt-PENTA as the General Contractor for the next phase of construction and
16		development of TOGE's West Valley Resort; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Pre-Con Agreement and the Construction Agreement negotiated between
18		TOGE and Hunt-PENTA requires a modification of the limited waiver of
19		immunity within Section 8(b)(2) of the Enterprise's Charter solely for purposes of
20		these Agreements and for the sole benefit of Hunt-PENTA; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Enterprise is seeking approval from the Legislative Council for this
22		modification to the scope of the waiver of the TOGE's immunity pursuant to the
23		terms of both the Pre-Con Agreement and the Construction Agreement, which is
24		incorporated by this reference; and
25	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the language
26		of the proposed waiver and believes it is in the best interest of the Nation to
27		adopt a resolution that approves those modifications; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Nation's best interest will be served by modifying TOGE's statutory waiver of
29		sovereign immunity as provided in the attached Exhibit A.
30	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council grants a
31		limited waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Tohono O'odham Gaming
32		Enterprise in favor of Hunt-PENTA solely for the purpose of compliance with the
33		covenants made in the Agreement and adopts the attached Exhibit A for that
34		purpose; provided that the Tohono O'odham Nation's sovereign immunity is not
35		waived and the Nation shall have no liability with respect to any claims or other
36		obligations asserted against the Enterprise or arising out of its operations.
